

Prince William 4-H Youth/Adult Training and Development Fund

Prince William 4-H receives support through the sale of poinsettias/nuts, grants, and donations. The 4-H Advisory Council Finance Committee designates a portion of these funds to support 4-Hers and 4-H volunteers. The Prince William 4-H Youth/Adult Training Development Fund provides assistance for 4-H competition entry fees, 4-H camp scholarships, scholarships for training and support for club projects. The following application is for 4-H adult volunteers and 4-H youth. The 4-H Finance Committee will review applications. For granted request, one-half the amount approved can be available immediately -the remaining half provided upon proof of completion of course/event/project. In general, scholarships are for no more than 50% of the cost of the registration fee. The consideration for scholarships is on a case-by-case basis.

Factors for awarding scholarships:

- Applicant is responsible for remaining cost of training (pay personally or secure other funding).
- After the event, applicant is responsible for completing written paragraph on skills learned and ways to share learning with club or county program.
- Consideration of applicant's tenure and overall commitment to 4-H
- Applicant's involvement in the 4-H annual fund raiser
- Applicant's previous scholarship reports and documentation.
